As such there will be further opportunity to provide comments on the proposed HRO direction to the Marine Management Organisation once the application is made."

	a. Steering Group – date TBC. AGREED unlikely to be before November.	
NDP/271	Any Other Business – following recommendations made to Full Council:	
	a. PA19/02360/PREAPP, Highfields, Lanteglos – AGREED that this should be opposed on grounds of being inappropriate development in AONB; is outside the building line; Does not conform with Policies 1, 9 and 10 in our emerging Neighbourhood Plan; does not satisfy criteria for infill, rounding-off and local need. There are already at least four properties for sale in Highway, one of which has remained unsold since it was built. There are also concerns in creating a new entrance/exit onto Highway just after the entrance to the hamlet on a bend where traffic-calming measures have recently been installed. These are Highways issues. Neighbours are upset by the proposal and all will oppose.	
	b. A letter had been received from Mrs Alison Voelcker containing the Formal Response from Cornwall Council to a request for PA18/02978/PREAPP advice for Fowey Harbour Hotel for extension to the existing hotel to include new spa, guest rooms, improvements to the bar, new apartments and improvements to car-parking. This would have a significant impact on the Fowey Conservation area and the AONB as the hotel is a large and prominent building well sited in its relationship to neighbouring properties and coastline. AGREED to oppose any development which could only be considered to be over-development of what was already a going concern and which would have significant detrimental impact on our residents' and visitors' enjoyment of the western side of the harbour. This could not be said to conserve the landscape and any development of such a scale should be limited. This has not yet been formally received by the Parish Council, but they will be notified by these minutes.
